## Consists of two “groups” (reflected in the name of the department)

- One group develops databases and end-user applications for the university museums of Norway and The Faculty of Medicine. These are big, funded projects stretching over several years.
- The other group, the TASK group, gives courses in IT tools (ML (in R), NVivo, Python, R, SPSS, Stata) and offers advance user support. The latter includes helping with data management in the broadest sense, from harvesting data, through combining data (sets) from different sources to helping with publication of results, e.g. visualizations of the results of the research, both inside and outside TSD (services for sensitive data). (Free support/service up to a point, approx. one week. May entail yearly operations cost.)
